If insurance coverage is obtained, exhibitor must declare the value of the insured item(s).
- Each exhibitor will share their entered items in a show-and-tell format, which includes information and ideas by the exhibitor, appraiser and the audience.
- Document or provenance is helpful and will be returned at the appraisal.
- Items selected as most valuable will be on display (in locked cases) for the duration of the Fair.
- The “Most Valuable Overall” item will be selected by the appraiser, Mike Clum.
- Entrants will be mailed a Gate 2 Load/Unload parking permit.
- There is a \$5.00 fee per item entered, IF entered by the above Entry Deadline.
- **On Site Registration:** Exhibitors may register their entry the day of the event. The registration fee is \$10.00 per item.
- If you are not sure which class to place your item, please consult a reputable antique dealer for assistance.
- The entry tag should be attached with a twistee tie to part of the entry. The name and address portion of the entry tag will be covered for display during the Fair.

**Judging Guidelines:**

- Entries must be at least 50 years old.
- Age; condition; rarity; value.

1. China – includes, but not limited to, R. S. Prussia, French Austrian, German, American, English, Japanese or other china ..... \$10 and Rosette
2. Art Pottery – includes, but not limited to, Hull, Rookwood, Roseville, Van Briggle, Weller Pottery ..... \$10 and Rosette
3. Antique Glassware – includes pressed, cut, colored or crystal pieces including Carnival, Depression and Elegant glass ..... \$10 and Rosette
4. Textiles – includes, but not limited to, handmade quilts, coverlets, samplers, vintage articles of clothing, needlework or other woven items..... \$10 and Rosette
5. Pocket Watches – includes both ladies and men’s watches ..... \$10 and Rosette
6. Ohio State Fair Memorabilia – includes souvenir, advertising items, postcards, or badges. .... \$10 and Rosette
7. Toys – includes wooden, lithographed, tin, iron or early plastic ..... \$10 and Rosette

**Division Notes:**

- The maximum size of an exhibit is 15” deep, 15” high and/or 30” long.
- At least three items comprising the collection must be exhibited; however, up to ten items may be displayed as long as they fit within the size limitations.
- Entry must be ready for display. No assembly by Creative Arts staff should be required.
- All entries MUST be accompanied by a 5”x 8” card (typed or printed on front of card only) with the following information:
  1. How the collection was started.
  2. Year the collection was started.
  3. Size of collection (number of items or amount of time spent).

- All entries **MUST** be accompanied by a 5"x7" photo of the entire collection.
- Collections exhibited from prior State Fairs are not eligible for entry.
- Coin, currency, or stamp collections are not accepted.
- Electrical hook-ups for displays are not available.
- The entry tag should be attached with a twistee tie to part of the entry.

- Uniqueness; presentation of collection; scope/completeness of collection; general appeal.
