- All entries will be displayed in the Creative Arts DiSalle Center throughout the Fair.
- Entries will not exceed 4’x4’x4’ and must be securely attached to a wagon that can easily be pulled by a walking adult.
- First place winners in each class and the Commissioner’s Choice will each receive a trophy and a ribbon made of Duck® Brand Duct Tape.

Judging Guidelines:
