Holiday Creations

- Either a Junior Grange or Grange Youth group will teach a fun craft each day.
- A mix of junior and youth members may work together to teach the craft of the day (participants may take their craft home with them).
- A schedule and special creation ideas must be submitted to the Junior or Youth director by July 1, 2007. A schedule must include at least one morning and one afternoon class. A schedule date for each group will be determined/approved by the director(s), who will then notify each group.

Talent Contest

- Date/Time/Location: **August 4, 2007** at 3pm in the Youth Discovery Center
- Positions:
 - Instrumental Solo
 - Junior Chorus (4 or more)
 - Miscellaneous - modern or traditional dance, baton, skits, instrumental or piano duets, etc. (anything not covered above)
 - Piano Solo
 - Reading
 - Vocal Duet
 - Vocal Solo
- Two age groups:
 - 5-9 and 10-14 (except chorus, which is 5-14)
 - In other categories with multiple participants, the age groups will be based on the oldest participant. Age break is based on age at the State Talent contest finals, August 4, 2007.
 - Participant must be five by the first district contest and cannot be 15 by September 30, 2007.
 - Participant must be a Junior Grange member in good standing.
- Accompanist may be a junior or adult, and may use a tape/CD provided that there are no voices on the recording for the vocal entries (karaoke type CD's may be used).
- District winners will perform the same number in the state contest.

- Memorization is required in all categories except piano and instrumental solo (juniors only).
- A six-minute time limit applies to all categories.
- There will be no county contests. All contestants will compete in the district of their choice, but can compete in only one district.
- Each junior may compete in a given category only once per year.
- The Junior Directors and State Lecturer have the authority to revise the schedule if there are insufficient entries to justify holding a district contest as scheduled.
- Junior entry blanks are available in the Ohio Granger Magazine and the Junior Leader Handbook, and must be sent to the junior directors by the May 20, 2007 deadline. District schedule and location will also be advertised in the Ohio Granger Magazine.
- District contests will begin at 12:30pm (unless the number of entries dictate an earlier start time).
- Score sheets will be given to contestants per category entered, prior to the district talent contests.
- **AWARDS** – A plaque will be given to the state winner in each category, and a district winner ribbon will be given to the other participants in the state contest.

Junior Signing Contest

- Immediately follows the Junior Talent Contest.
- Entry forms must be submitted by May 20, 2007 to the State Junior directors.
- *Song:*
 - Individual 5-9 and 10-14
 - Group 5-14 (two or more group members)
- *Prose, Poetry and Spoken Work:*
 - 5-9 and 10-14
- Signing contestants will perform at the district talent contest for the experience and to be critiqued. There will be no elimination at this time. District signing participants will compete at the state talent contest.
- The audible work must be used while the contestant is signing, and may be a recording, an adult, another junior, or the contestant.
- ASL (American Sign Language) shall be used.
- Other than the above, the rules of the talent contest apply.
- **AWARDS** – A plaque will be given to the state winners in each category. Participation ribbons will be given to all participants.
