

## Scholarship Application

### **The Governor James A. Rhodes Junior Fair Endowment Fund Scholarship**

This scholarship is open to all Junior Fair Exhibitors who will be incoming freshmen or undergraduate students at The Ohio State University College of Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, or OSU-ATI, Wooster. You may apply for this scholarship as well as any one of the Ohio State Fair Scholarships.

### **OHIO STATE FAIR SCHOLARSHIPS**

In an effort to recognize the quality youth of Ohio, and to help those interested in furthering their education, the Ohio Expositions Commission has established a Scholarship Program. The purpose of these scholarships is to assist high school seniors (by the fall of 2008-2009) and graduates who are continuing their education at an accredited institution in an undergraduate course of study in any field. Scholarships will be awarded to junior exhibitors during the Ohio State Fair. Applicants will be judged on Scholastic Standing, Citizenship and Leadership, Ohio State Fair Participation, County Fair Participation, and Financial Need.

#### **RULES**

1. The applicant must be a high school senior (school year 2008-2009) or who is a high school graduate continuing their education at an accredited institution.
2. Applicant must reside in the state of Ohio and have been an active participant in the Ohio State Fair Junior Division, as well as their local county Fair.
3. To be eligible, applicant must be a participant in Junior Fair (not older than 19 years as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of current year) and still be eligible to show at their County Fair and the Ohio State Fair.
4. Print the application (located below), answer ALL questions, and mail it to:

5. A high school and/or college transcript and copies of ACT and/or SAT scores MUST be attached.
6. Applications MUST be postmarked by July 1<sup>st</sup> of current year.
7. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to accept or reject applicants. The Committee also reserves the right not to award scholarship(s) where applicants may not fulfill requirements.
8. Applications will be judged on the following basis:
  - Scholastic Standing - 25%
  - Citizenship & Leadership - 25%
  - Ohio State Fair Participation - 25%
  - County Fair Participation - 20%
  - Financial Need - 5%
9. The Scholarship Committee may request applicant interviews.
10. Applicants may apply for only one Ohio State Fair Scholarship Division.
11. Previous winners are not eligible to compete.
12. An exhibitor may win a scholarship only one time.

13. Scholarship recipients will be notified by August 1<sup>st</sup> of current year. Scholarship will be awarded during the Ohio State Fair Sale of Champions on Sunday, August 9<sup>th</sup>.
